2233. BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Minutes of May 1, 2018 (Regular Meeting), May 14, 2018 (Expulsion Hearings), May 14, 2018 (Special Meeting/Board Work Session), May 15, 2018 (Regular Meeting), and May 22, 2018 (Special Meeting) are being presented for approval.

2234. APPROVAL OF WORKERS COMPENSATION POLICY BID

The Superintendent recommends approval of the winning Workers Compensation policy bid by Brickstreet Insurance. The policy will cover all workplace injuries for the employees of Cabell County Schools with an annual premium of \$794,092. The period of this policy will be from July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.

2235. PURCHASE OF CUSTODIAL SUPPLIES FOR 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

The Superintendent recommends approval for the purchase of custodial supplies from General Sales Co.* for the 2018 – 2019 school year. Bid items were narrowed down so that alternatives could be inspected and substituted. Bids were opened on May 9, 2018.

2236. PURCHASE OF FOOD AND SUPPLIES FOR 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

The Superintendent recommends the approval to purchase food and supplies not to exceed \$4,362,198.00 from US Foods GPO Premier by the Food Service Department for the 2018-2019 school year. Funding source will be provided by the Food Service Program.

2237. SCHOOL TRIP REQUEST – CABELL MIDLAND HIGH SCHOOL

The Superintendent recommends approval of Cabell Midland High School’s trip request for members of the CMHS National Beta Club to travel to Savannah, GA, on June 16-21, 2018, to participate in the National Senior Beta Convention and competitions. Eight (8) students will be traveling along with six (6) chaperones, including teacher/sponsor Jennifer Wiley. No days of school will be missed and transportation will be provided by parents. Expenses will be paid from school funds. Verbal permission was granted by the Superintendent.

2238. SCHOOL TRIP REQUEST – CABELL MIDLAND HIGH SCHOOL

The Superintendent recommends approval of Cabell Midland High School’s trip request for students in the football program to travel to Morgantown, WV, on June 22-23, 2018, to participate in the WVU Football Camp 7 on 7 Lineman Challenge. Approximately 100 students will be traveling along with six (6) chaperones as well as parents. No days of school will be missed and transportation will be provided by County Bus and parents. Expenses will be paid from school funds.

2239. APPROVAL OF FIRST TIME WAIVER OF STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY REGARDING ADVANCED PLACEMENT TRAINING

The Superintendent recommends approval of Huntington High School’s request to submit a first time waiver of Policy 2510 regarding mandatory Advanced Placement training every 3rd year. Due to scheduling conflicts, the AP Music teacher is unable to attend the training. Approval of the waiver by the State Board will allow the teacher to attend training in summer of 2019.

2240. RENEWAL OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN CABELL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND CABELL HUNTINGTON HOSPITAL

The Superintendent recommends approval of the interagency agreement with Cabell Huntington Hospital, a health care provider in Huntington West Virginia, to provide an opportunity for students enrolled in the School of Practical Nursing at the Cabell County Career and Technology Center to observe and acquire clinical experience in the school year 2018-2019. The agreement shall be automatically extended for successive one year periods after the initial term unless one party notifies the other of its intent not to renew.

2241. RENEWAL OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN CABELL COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND ST. MARY'S MEDICAL CENTER

The Superintendent recommends approval of the interagency agreement by and between The Cabell County Board of Education and St. Mary's Medical Center for the purpose of providing education experience(s) for students enrolled in the Cabell County Career and Technology Center School of Practical Nursing, beginning July 1, 2018 and effective until June 30, 2019. This agreement shall be renewed annually automatically upon the same terms and conditions.
