2193. BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Minutes of May 16, 2017 (Regular Meeting), May 17, 2017 (Special Meeting), May 23, 2017 (Special Meeting), and May 30, 2017 (Expulsion Hearings) are being presented for approval.

2194. AGREEMENT FOR ATHLETIC TRAINING SERVICES BETWEEN MARSHALL HEALTH AND CABELL COUNTY SCHOOLS

The Superintendent recommends approval of the agreement for Marshall Health, DBA Marshall Sports Medicine Institute to provide four to six (4 to 6) N.A.T.A. certified athletic trainers. Two trainers will work for Cabell Midland High School and one will work for Huntington High School for the 2017-2018 school year. Another trainer will rotate among all four middle schools. Marshall Health will provide all athletic trainers at no cost (\$0.00) to the County. This agreement is renewable up to three years if all parties agree to the terms.

2206. PURCHASE OF DELL CHROMEBOOKS AND CHARGING CARTS

The Superintendent recommends approval for the purchase of 810 Dell Chromebooks and twenty-four 36 station Dell Charging Carts. This purchase also includes licensing and 3-year warranty. Placement of the Chromebooks and charging units will be as follows: One for every World Language teacher; two for each high school math department, one for Our Lady of Fatima School through Title I funds. A *Request for Proposal* was disseminated and through the competitive bidding process, nCompass Networks was the lowest bidder. The source of funding for this purchase will be County Step 7 and Title I.

2207. <u>SALE OF SURPLUS BUSES, MISCELLANEOUS BUS PARTS, VARIOUS USED TOOLS, PARTS, AND EQUIPMENT</u>

The Superintendent recommends approval for the Transportation Department to sell surplus school buses, miscellaneous bus parts, various used tools, parts, and equipment. There are three ways by which it is legal to dispose of surplus property. Items may be sold directly to an institution which qualifies as a 503C agency, by public auction or by scrapping. The auction service of choice is Public Surplus, an internet based auction service. There is no listing fee. The only fee is 8% of the selling price when the item actually sells and this 8% is added to the sale price and paid by the buyer. This auction service meets the legal requirements for disposing of surplus property.
