The Superintendent recommends approval for the renewal of nCompass Networks as the Technology Department's computer maintenance vendor for 2016-2017 school year. nCompass has agreed to extend the current contracted rates. The rates are \$70.00 per hour for General Technician Services and \$80.00 per hour for Network Engineering Services. The source of funding will be the Technology Department's maintenance line item budget (\$100,000) and E-Rate (\$140,000). The contract is not to exceed \$240,000. **This is the second and final renewal for this contract.**
