1) BARBOURSVILLE MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS RECEIVE STATEWIDE 'UNSTOPPABLE AWARD'

Jillian Freeman and Olivia Turman, students at Barboursville Middle School, received the WV Healthy Kids Healthy Families 'Unstoppable Award' for their advocacy work on education policy in December. Turman and Freeman both addressed the West Virginia Board of Education during its meeting in August 2017 on their stand to keep West Virginia school nutrition standards strong as the new WVDE Policy 4321.1 was online for 30-day public comment. The two Cabell County students made public comments on the policy and also encouraged others prior to the need of the comment period to make comments on the policy so the board would not take steps backwards on the state policy.

Turman and Freeman also received a *Try This WV* mini grant in 2016 to build a healthy concessions cart which features a people-powered smoothie bike and small physical activity equipment.
