Parking on campus is a privilege. The following are guidelines that all student drivers (permanent and temporary permit holders) are required to follow. All student drivers and their parents are required to sign a Parking Contract before a tag will be issued.

Drug Testing Consent Form- All students wishing to purchase a Huntington High School parking permit will be required to sign a Drug Testing Consent Form (attached to this form) and participate in random drug testing. Students refusing to participate in drug testing will not be permitted to purchase a Huntington High School parking permit or to park on campus.

PARKING REGULATIONS

(Students, please initial to indicate you have read and understand each item.)

- _____ 1) All vehicles parked on school grounds must display/hang the current tag from the front of the vehicle. Parking privileges may be revoked if the tag is not displayed correctly.
- _____ 2) Parking regulations are enforced. It is considered a privilege to park on school grounds. Suspension of parking privileges, revocation of tags, towing of vehicles, and/or other disciplinary action may occur for parking violations.
- _____ 3) NO REFUNDS will be given for revoked parking passes. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR SCHOOL CLOSURES.
- _____ 4) Parking is strictly limited to the student parking area. Students parking in designated faculty, visitor, or handicapped areas may be towed.
- _____ 5) All student drivers must be licensed and covered by insurance. Cabell County Schools and Huntington High School are **NOT** responsible for damages or theft to vehicles parked on school property.
- _____ 6) Parking lot speed shall not exceed 5 miles per hour. Reckless and/or irresponsible operation is cause for revocation of parking privileges. A student shall not intentionally, nor recklessly, operate a motor vehicle so as to endanger the safety, health and/or welfare of others on school property.
- _____ 7) Students who park on campus after privileges have been revoked may receive additional disciplinary consequences.
- _____ 8) All regulations of the student handbook apply to the parking lot, including tobacco violations. Students are not to loiter in the parking area nor are they to sit in their vehicles while parked on school grounds. Excessive tardies or absences (3 or more) as well as chronic classroom misbehavior may result in loss of driving and parking privileges. The school will cooperate fully with police investigations, including but not limited to the use of canine patrol programs subject to Board of Education policy.
- _____ 9) Student vehicles are subject to search. Any student who exercises the privilege of parking an automobile on school ground shall be considered to have given implied consent to a search of such automobile at any time a search is requested by the school administration.
- _____ 10) Falsifying a contract, permitting others to use your permit, misrepresenting a tag as lost or stolen, or displaying a tag not registered to you are causes for revocation of a parking permit, and additional disciplinary consequences.
- _____ 11) If a student changes vehicles at any point during the school year, the parking tag must be moved to the new vehicle. There is no additional charge in such a case.) If a student forgets to switch the pass to another vehicle registered with the school, they must come to the main office to receive a temporary pass for their vehicle at no cost. Under no circumstances should a car be parked without a permit.
- _____ 12) Any student who pulls into the parking lot at the bottom of the hill to avoid the traffic light will receive a warning for the first offense and will lose their pass on the second offense.

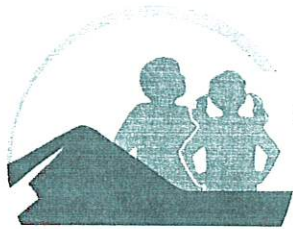
