Arrival/Departure


Arrive on Sunday from 2:00—4:00 p.m. Leave on Saturday after 9:00 a.m. Only register if you can and will attend for the total time.

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To make Horseshoe affordable to as many as possible, Horseshoe fees are about one-half of our actual costs.
