BMS LSIC Meeting for 4th 9 Weeks May 5, 2025 @ 6:00

1) Academics

- a. We discussed WVGSA scores for the 2024-2025 SY. The school made gains in both ELA/Reading and Math.
- b. The iReady EOY tests are scheduled for 05/12/25 and 05/13/25. Students who raise their score by five points will be rewarded with a trip to Malibu Jacks on 05/19/25.
- c. The district's special education audit results were reviewed. While many schools were out of compliance on a variety of issues, BMS got a glowing report, only citing a need for training on the creation and implementation of behavior plans -- which was an issue for the entire district.

2) Attendance

- a. We discussed our success with the monthly homeroom attendance reward party.
- b. Chronic absenteeism is still an issue. While our attendance rate is the highest of the four middle schools in the district, we are struggling to get a small pocket of our student population to be at school more consistently.

3) Behavior

- a. The school's total number of disciplinary issues is the lowest of the four middle schools in the district. We attribute this to our focus on social and emotional awareness.
- b. Students who have no behavior referrals beyond two days of detention for the second semester, will be rewarded on 05/20/25 with Outdoor Inflatables games and a dunking booth.
- c. P.R.I.D.E students for the current grading term and for the year, will be recognized at the award's ceremony scheduled for 05/28/25.

4) Strategic Plan

- a. Updating the school goals in the strategic plan for the 2025-206 SY was discussed. Due to changes in district initiatives (i.e., abandoning Thinking Maps), some goals are going to have to be either replaced or severely rewritten.
