

How to Read the West Virginia SAT School Day Score Report: A GUIDE FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- 5 Your Student's Scores and Achievement Levels** for Evidence-based Reading and Writing (ERW), Science, and Math as determined by the West Virginia SAT School Day given in the spring.
- 6 Comparison Scores** allow you to compare your student's scores with the average scores for your student's school, the district, and the state. Please note the COVID-19 pandemic may have influenced assessment results.
- 7 Your Student's Performance in the ERW Subscores:** Words in Context, Command of Evidence, Standard English Conventions, and Expression of Ideas.
- 8 Your Student's Scores** plotted on a number line with the Achievement Levels shown.
- 9 Your Student's Performance in the Math Subscores:** Heart of Algebra, Problem Solving, Data Analysis, and passport to Advanced Math.
